Chamber Choir classes are spent rehearsing a themed program of 7 or 8 songs. We work on mastering the music, words, rhythm and style of each song to build a beautiful choral sound. We work on choral music that includes a variety of genres, typically including Broadway, pop, and American Songbook. Rehearsals are a time to enjoy ensemble singing with supportive folks who also enjoy choral singing.

An example theme from the past was “Sing Hallelujah!”, featuring “Hallelujah” by Leonard Cohen, “Hallelujah! I Love Her So” by Ray Charles, as well as songs by Harold Arlen, Harry Belafonte, and Robert Burns.

At the end of the semester we perform a Lobby Concert in Arsht Hall and a community outreach concert.
