COURSE TITLE

Robert Burns: Scotland's Bard

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Explore the life, times, poetry, and songs of Robert Burns. Each work presented will include a discussion of its background, its significance to Burns, and an English glossing of Scots words and phrases. The class will listen to recordings of each work as read or sung by a native Scots professional performer. Biographical and historical information on Burns and his times will supplement the class presentations. The instructor will provide all materials needed for the class.

COURSE CONTENT

The class will read, discuss, and listen to professional recitations of poems and songs written by Robert Burns. Each work will be presented as follows:

- 1. A link to the poems will be emailed to students before each class.
- 2. The instructor will discuss the background of each work and its importance to Burns. 3. Each work will include an English glossing of Scots words and phrases.
- 4. The class will listen to a professionally recorded performance of each poem or song. 5. Biographical information on Burns will be presented throughout the course using PowerPoint slides, audio recordings, and videos.
