I propose to continue the GIG on Zoom, at the casual level that we did it in-person pre-pandemic. I will have weekly themes (see below), loosely correlated with the Genealogy Overview Class earlier in the day, led by Reg Herzog, for which I will again be a co-leader and for which I am giving 2 lectures. For each theme I will have a short presentation prepared, or will solicit presentations from the group as interest dictates. This will be followed by collaboration and discussion among the class members.

Carol Callaghan has agreed to be my VA, and Reg Herzog has also been helping out.

In past years, in addition to being an enjoyable collaboration in which experienced genealogists share helpful information with beginners, the GIG has been a steppingstone for some of us, to gain some experience giving short presentations, leading to the confidence to give longer lectures subsequently, and enlarging the genealogy community at OLLI. I hope to foster this trend once again, although I am having a rough go of it on Zoom. The same technology that enables greater participation by students in multiple locations also adds an extra layer of intimidation to prospective presenters. I'd appreciate any advice on this aspect.
