SYLLABUS COURSE DESCRIPTION

Course Title: Online Civility in The Age of Social Media: Are We more Connected or Disconnected? **Course Description:** The aim of this course is to create an awareness about the concepts "**Online Civility and** Incivility" in the age of Social Media. As Humans we are all bonding with social norms and values that strengthen our interconnectedness via all channels of communication including Social Media.
