Course Description

Each week, the class discusses the pros and cons of a topic of interest,

based on materials intended for native speakers. The selected readings or videos supply both authentic language models as well as insight into how native speakers view the subject at hand. Each reading or video includes explanations of key words and cultural references, and is provided to class members one week prior to each class session. Since the goal of the course is to promote a lively exchange, improve speaking skills and expand students' knowledge, a relaxed and accepting atmosphere is crucial.
