

La Lorraine: birthplace of Joan of Arc

Course Description

In this course, participants will learn about the tumultuous history of the former province Lorraine often paired with Alsace. Although it's the birthplace of Joan of Arc as well as the Ecole de Nancy known as Art Nouveau, it is better known as a spoil for the winner of successive wars between France and Prussia and subsequently, between France and Germany.

They will savor, virtually, the cuisine influenced by its German neighbor. They will become familiar with the quiche Lorraine that has its origins in this region. They will learn about the "straw wine", vin de paille of Toul, the porcelain of Lunéville and the world famous crystal Daum.

They will enjoy a panoramic view of Place Stanislas on Bastille Day and visit the inclined boat elevator of Arzviller. The course will be taught in French.
